**Degree:** Associate in Science (with MnTC complete)

**Length:** 60 credits

**Program Information:** The Associate in Science Degree in Accounting is designed to provide a strong foundation of knowledge and skills for students interested in transferring on to earn a four year degree in accounting, for those planning on entering the workforce, or for those starting their own business.

The Associate in Science Degree affords easy transfer to other institutions through completion of the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MnTC). Please see your ICC counselor for further information.

The Associate in Science Degree in Accounting will be awarded for successful completion of the course listed below. Recipients of this degree shall be prepared for transfer to Bemidji State University's Accounting B.S.

The purpose of this transfer guide is to provide a sequenced curriculum of courses recommended by the receiving institution taken within the Associate in Science degree at ICC.

1. 60 credits
2. Specific program requirements
3. Grade point average of 2.00 minimum
4. A minimum of 40 general education credits
5. A minimum of 20 credits must be completed at Itasca Community College
