

ASSOCIATE IN SCIENCE DEGREE

The Associate in Science Degree may be awarded for successful completion of programs which have highly structured professional-level technical requirements. Recipients of this degree shall be prepared for transfer to baccalaureate majors in the same field. A majority of liberal arts and science courses shall be prerequisite to, or specifically supportive of, certain technical courses.

Candidates for the Associate in Science Degree from Itasca Community College must complete the following minimum requirements:

1. 64 credits.
2. A minimum GPA of 2.00.
