*Note: Courses numbered below 1000 do NOT transfer.

The Associate in Science Degree in Applied Psychology/Human Services will be awarded for successful completion of the courses listed below. The following minimum requirements must be completed:

1. 60 credits
2. Specific program requirements
3. Grade point average of 2.00 minimum
4. A minimum of 40 general education credits
5. A minimum of 20 credits must be completed at Itasca Community College
