**Itasca Community College-University of North Dakota
College of Business and Public Administration**

The Airport Management curriculum is offered to those students seeking administrative positions with companies specializing in or related to the ground activities of the aviation industry. Foundational aspects of the general aviation and air carrier segments, as well as the overall aviation industry will be studied in-depth. However, sufficient flexibility in courses will allow the student to concentrate in a particular area of the industry such as general aviation operations, airline operations, airline management, airport administration, or corporate aviation management. **Completion of either Aviation 101, Survey of Flight, or Aviation 102, Introduction to Aviation, is required.** This is a 4-year program leading to a Bachelor of Business Administration with a major in Airport Management.

Students following the suggested course schedule below indicate that they are pursuing the Associate in Arts degree at Itasca Community College (ICC) with the intent to transfer to the above named institution. The purpose of this transfer guide is to provide a sequenced curriculum of courses recommended by the receiving institution taken within the Associate in Arts degree at ICC.

*Note: Courses numbered below 1000 and courses with a “D” grade or lower do NOT transfer.

The Minnesota Transfer Curriculum and Itasca's Associate in Arts Degree

The public higher education colleges and universities in Minnesota have developed a common liberal education curriculum called the **Minnesota Transfer Curriculum**. Students who complete the Associate in Arts degree at Itasca Community College will have automatically met all Minnesota Transfer Curriculum requirements. Both North Dakota State University (NDSU) and the University of North Dakota (UND) accept the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum as fulfilling their general education requirements. Please note, however, certain majors require specific general education courses as pre-requisites to their program.
