Students in sport management become highly trained managers who find success in complex and varied sports settings. The program incorporates a broad base of course work in many disciplines, including exercise and sport science, business and communication skills.

Students who desire to major in sport management must apply to the program after completing (or be in the process of completing) 45 semester credits. Final selection for entrance into the sport management emphasis is limited. Students must meet selection and retention criteria and complete a semester internship. Other areas of emphasis include: Fitness, Physical Education Teacher Certification, and Athletic Training.
